

# Anti-Bullying Week 2010 screensaver competition



## Information for teachers

We'd like to invite Key Stage 2 and 3 pupils to take part in a screensaver design competition for Anti-Bullying Week 2010, which runs 15-19 November. It's a quick, creative task for pupils which can also give your school a starting point to talk about plans for the week.

**'Taking action together'** is the theme of this year's campaign. We know that significant numbers of children and young people who witness bullying still don't tell anyone or take action to stop it; we know there are still schools, streets, buses, play areas and homes where children do not feel safe from bullying but together we can take action to change this.

The winning designs chosen from the Key Stage 2 and 3 categories will be used as part of this year's Anti-Bullying Alliance campaign and will help to remind children, young people and adults that bullying is wrong and needs to be tackled by the whole community.

There will be individual prizes for the winners and their schools will also win free Anti-Bullying Week 2010 merchandise.
